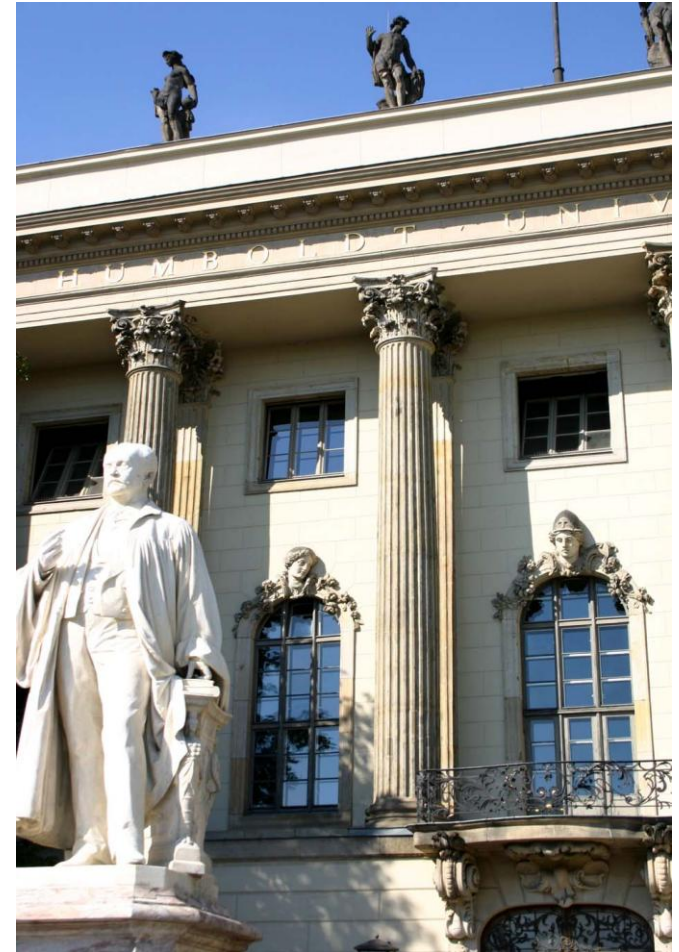

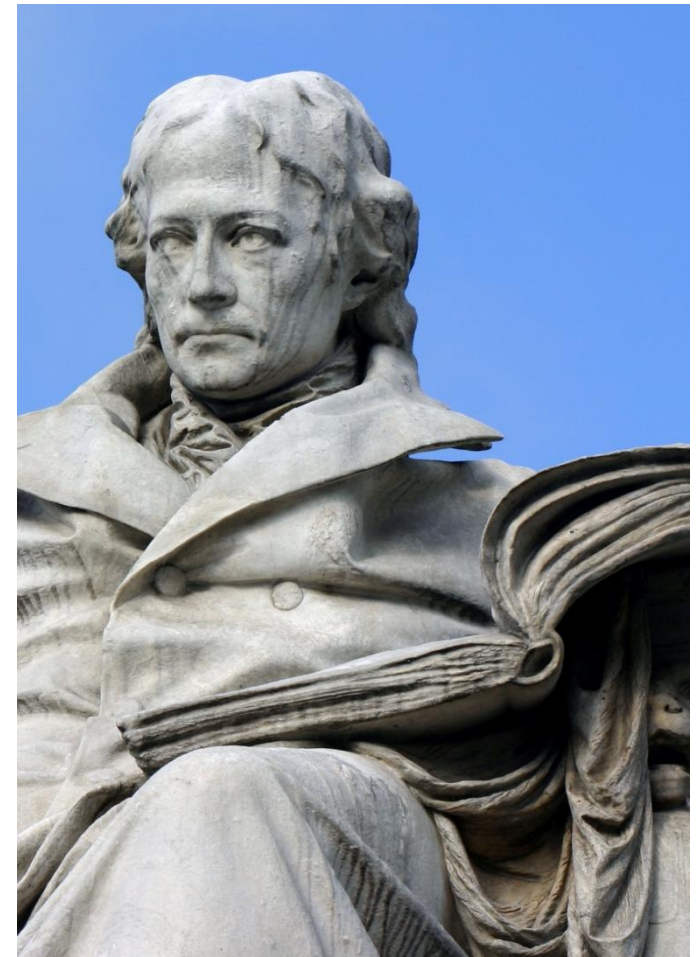
The Modern Classic

His vision:

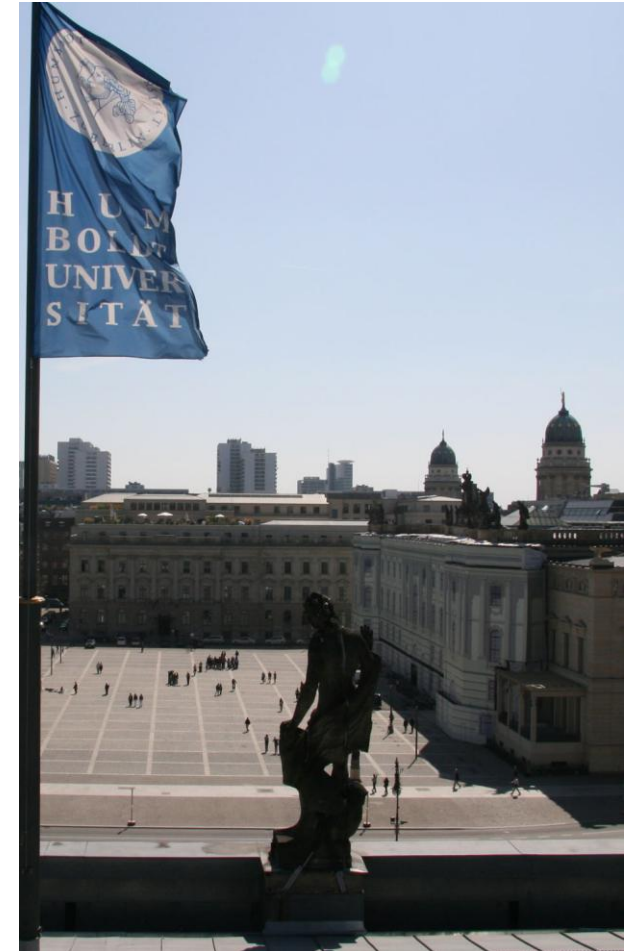
- to uphold the ideal of research without restrictions
- to provide an all-round education
- the unity of research and teaching

These principles soon became general practice throughout the world. A new era of university and academic research had begun.



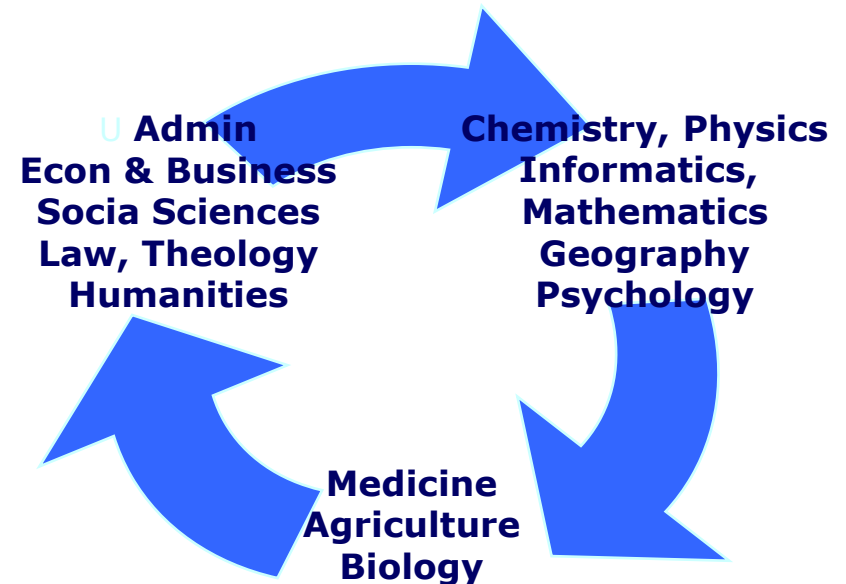
Humboldt – Figures 2012

- **Students: approx. 30.000 students**
International students: 13 %
Women: 47,5 %
- **Professorships: 384, Academic staff total 1,659**
- **11 Faculties (w/ Charité)**
- **Systemic: BA, MA, Doktoranden, Ph.D., Diplom, Magister, Staatsexamen, Teacher´s Qualification**
- **Budget: 255 Million € (state)
69 Million € (third party funding, w/o Charité)**

Study programmes of particular relevance for EMA-2

- **Generally, all study programmes - Undergraduate, Master and doctoral courses - at HU (except Medicine) are open to applicants for EMA-2 mobility grants.**
- **you may apply for programme studies (without degree)**
- **for degree studies**
- **please note – for acceptance in degree studies the official accession criteria of the respective program apply and you must provide all documents in the format as requested by the program – this may be provided, however after a selection for an EMA grant and its conditional confirmation.**
- **EMA grants do not cover study periods at the foreign partner universities in International programs.**



PhD Education at HUB - entrance requirements

- **MSc degree**
- **Transcript of the academic record with excellent results (top 20%)**
- **Statement of motivation**
- **Curriculum Vitae**
- **English test results: (to be specified case by case)- in principle**
 - **IELTS: Overall grade 7.0 (with a minimum sub score of 6.0 for each module)**
 - **TOEFL: Paper based 600, computer based 250, internet based 100 & TWE 100 (for all three)**
- **Preliminary research proposal (2 pages)**
- **Two reference letters**
- **Acceptance by a HU supervisor**
