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I was at the University of Turku as Academic staff under «Erasmus Mundus Action 2 Triple I» Program from the 31st of January until the 31st of March, 2011.

Title of my research was “Russian and Finnish experience of philosophical discussion of Intellectual property in the informational activity: Comparative analysis”.

My ongoing local interests are connected to widening of base for philosophical analysis of Intellectual property in comparison with different types of non-material property.

Actually, participation in this program gave me much more opportunity for scientific research than I had previously. For example, in Russian universities I had never own office for scientific research. Department of Behavioral Sciences and Philosophy provided a room for scientific research, possibility of participation at theoretical seminars, contacts and discussions with scientific coordinator and colleagues.

The “Triple I” project gave an opportunity to get criticism from Finnish colleagues face-to-face, to discuss and to compare different approaches to philosophical analysis of the intellectual property in the informational activity. It helped to get objective evaluation. So research work was of benefit from it.

The results of research were delivered for an International Conference “International Cooperation: Integration of Educational Areas” (Udmurt State University, Izhevsk - Russia).

The visit enhanced cooperation between Udmurt State University (UdSU) and University of Turku in the field of methodological and philosophical analysis of the intellectual property in the informational activity. This project provided an opportunity to use results of research in scientific researches and in educational process at UdSU. It was useful for exchange programs and interactions of UdSU with University of Turku.

The theme of the “Triple I” program – *‘Integration, Interaction and Institutions’* is essential for real scientific integration. Scientific researches supported by this program and its practical applications are necessary for development of Bologna process of integration of European educational institutions and for entering Russian Federation into World Trade Organization. So, this research is significant nationally and internationally.
